## SAA Article 16 Declaration of Understanding (January 2021)

The CAA have placed a mandatory requirement on the SAA to ensure that all SAA members operating within the Article 16 Authorisation, have read and understood the terms of the Article 16 Authorisation.

Additionally, that the SAA must record a declaration from each existing member that they have read and understood the terms before conducting any further flights under the Article 16 Authorisation.

Many members renewed their annual subscription prior to the introduction of the Article 16 declaration requirement and therefore were not asked to provide the required declaration.

**The SAA must now ask all existing members to sign and return this Article 16 declaration, by the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2021, for their continued membership of the SAA to remain valid.**
